Shri Kartikey Dubey, Advocate is present on behalf of the applicant.

The learned counsel for the applicant submitted that in pursuance of compliance of the provisions of Section 43(5) of the Act, the applicant has deposited an amount of Rs. 14,53,217/- vide D.D. No. 002312 dated 21.02.2023 drawn on IDBI Bank as per the order of Regulatory Authority and certificate of Chartered Accountant. Further submission of learned counsel for the applicant is that since the compliance of the provisions of Section 43(5) of the Act has been made and the appeal has been filed with delay, therefore, in the interest of justice, notice be issued to the respondent on the application for condonation of delay.

Let notice be issued to the respondent on the application for condonation of delay, returnable on 20.04.2023.

The Registry will generate a notice for 20.04.2023 and send the same through e-mail to the applicant and its counsel within 48 hours. The applicant after downloading the notice will send it through speed-post to the respondent annexing copy of application for condonation of delay as well as memo of appeal and its annexures within three days. The applicant will also send the copy of application for condonation of delay and memo of appeal and its annexures, annexing notice

issued by the Tribunal through e-mail to the respondent within three days. The applicant will file an affidavit of service annexing copy of postal receipt and transaction report of e-mail sent to the respondent as well as copy of the track record of the postal department regarding service of notice upon the respondent.

On receipt of the notice, it is open for the respondent to send objections to the application for condonation of delay and grounds of appeal to the applicant and its counsel through e-mail within 10 days. Reply, if any, will be sent by the applicant to the respondent within a week thereafter. The parties/legal representatives are directed to upload their respective objection/reply on the e-portal of the Tribunal immediately thereafter.

List this defective appeal on **20.04.2023** for consideration of application for condonation of delay and hearing.
