During the course of argument, Mr. Anagh Narain Shukla, learned counsel for appellant submitted that as per orders of Regulatory Authority time provided by RERA has passed for delivery of the flat in question. Learned counsel further submitted that for the purpose of recovery of amount, the appellant will file execution case before the Regulatory Authority and for compensation the appellant will move application before the Adjudicating Officer. Again, learned counsel for appellant submitted that in view of the above now, he does not want to press this appeal.

In the light of the above, the instant appeal is **disposed** of accordingly. The appellant is at liberty to file execution case before the Regulatory Authority and to move application for compensation before the Adjudicating Officer as per provisions of the Act.
